

2011 Port Huron Memorial Day Information

Memorial Day, Monday, May 30, 2011 – Line up begins at 10:00 a.m.

The Port Huron Memorial Day Parade is sponsored by the City of Port Huron and organized by Port Huron veteran organizations: American Legion Post 8 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 796. This parade honors U.S. military personnel who sacrificed their life for this great country as well as those who faithfully served and personnel currently serving.

Entry into the parade is open to veteran, civic, and fraternal organizations with a veteran or patriotic theme. Parade participants cannot "throw" candy or pass-out any form of literature. Attire, costumes, and floats must be appropriate and fitting for this patriotic event.

Special Note: Commercial and for-profit organizations are NOT allowed to display signs, banners, or other identifying advertising. Photos and a complete description of parade entrants may be required ten (10) days prior (May 20, 2011) to the event.
